



The non-porous nature of Staron means that no stain is ever permanent, providing a durable application that is both hygienic and easy to clean. In addition, Staron's inconspicuous joining method eliminates dirt-trapping crevices.

Staron is repairable, renewable and UV stable. Even after years of use it can simply be sanded and restored to its original condition. Staron does not have or require any finishing polishes or sealers; it is the same solid material throughout its thickness.

Staron is a premium silica-free solid surface offering an abundance of design potential to the building industry. Staron Solid Surfaces are Group 1 Fire rated to AS5637.1 (AUS) & Group 1S Fire rated to C/VM2 (NZ). [Learn more...](#)



Staron is joined using a specially formulated adhesive that chemically bonds the pieces together to create an inconspicuous, seamless surface, eliminating crevices where dirt and grime can collect.

Perfect for monolithic applications and the integration of detailed design features. Seamless joining can also be carried out on site, enabling the creation of large joinery pieces where access is restricted, such as areas requiring elevator access.

Staron offers excellent hygienic properties. Due to the homogeneous nature of the surface, it is both easy to maintain and no stain is ever permanent.

Routine cleaning is simple with the use of good-quality dishwashing liquid. For stubborn marks, products such as Jif® or Gumption® will assist to rejuvenate the surface.




## BENCHTOP + COVE INTEGRATION





The unique joining capabilities of solid surface allow for a small return to be seamlessly integrated at the back of the benchtop.

This return lifts the splashback slightly off the bench, eliminating the need for silicone along the back edge. It's an effective way to maintain a cleaner surface and prevent water from seeping into the rear of the benchtop. This detail is not only practical but also visually appealing, complementing tiles, glass and other materials beautifully.

The coved return can be scribed for a precise fit, ensuring the silicone is barely visible and removing the need to replace old or stained silicone over time.

Extending functionality further in wet-area design, a fully integrated Staron sink can be incorporated. This creates a seamless transition between benchtop and bowl, eliminating silicone joints and dirt-trapping areas for improved hygiene and ease of maintenance.



## BENCHTOP + SPLASHBACK INTEGRATION



For a fully seamless, integrated benchtop and splashback solution, Staron can be extended beyond the cove, offering the ultimate in easy maintenance and hygiene.

Extend the surface seamlessly from the benchtop to the windowsill, eliminating maintenance challenges in this area.

It can also be used to create integrated sills, cooktops, or shelves for a streamlined and functional design.

For renovations, this seamless return is particularly advantageous in kitchens when designing around windows that are positioned just above the sink, often creating a problematic area to finish. The ability to completely avoid silicone and grout in this highly exposed zone eliminates common failure points, delivering a smooth, join-free and hygienic solution that enhances durability and improves the overall finish.





Staron has a raw, authentic quality and does not require sealing. Over time, it develops a gentle patina that reflects how it is used, adding warmth and character to the home.

When renewal is desired, the surface can be easily sanded and restored to look as good as new, maintaining its elegance for years to come. With the ability to renew and repair Staron, the lifespan of a fitout can easily be extended. Reducing waste & contributing to a more sustainable design.

Building on this sustainability, Staron can also be upcycled and easily recreated into other applications and products.

An old kitchen benchtop can become a vanity or furniture pieces such as coffee tables and seating.

Additionally, with a little imagination Staron offcuts can be transformed into practical and creative items. 




Alternatively, **Mario Romano Walls®** offers a collection of more than 40 intricate patterns, available in non-repeating three-dimensional designs and two-dimensional variations. Using Mario Romano Walls technology, designs are carved into Staron and can be tailored to meet specific aesthetic or spatial needs. This ready-to-specify technology streamlines the process from concept to completion producing ready-to-install textured panels.

With seamless joining, thermoforming, and routing capabilities, the design potential is truly limitless.





Rixon Hair was designed with the objective of creating an intelligently planned, inclusive workspace, which reflects a sense of community and tranquillity.

The reception area is an important feature of the salon, being a critical pivot in the operations of the salon and the first point of entry for clients. It sets the tone for the salon and delivers a carefully considered first impression for customers as they exit the elevator and enter the salon space.

With these design requirements considered, a dramatic Staron-clad reception unit was created to draw the eye into the salon. LED lights were also added to the unit with a plywood product shelf that extends to a service counter.





With warm timbers and deep tones used in the flooring and walls, the gold ceiling feature and Mario Romano Walls joinery pair well together and add impact to the space. 


